

## MMI Network: Internal regulations

### Membership criteria and admission procedure

1. The criteria for Network membership as defined by the MMI Statutes and the Network policy are conclusive and cannot be extended without amendments of these key Network documents. No further formal criteria shall be used for admitting new members.
2. According to the Network policy, Network members
  - are working in the field of international health cooperation and/or global health;
  - share the Network members' vision of Health for All and support the mandate of the Network;
  - are committed to actively participate in Network activities and to contribute to the sustainability of the Network;
  - are able to fulfill the related duties, including the payment of an annual membership fee.
3. If an organization does not fulfill these criteria any more, the Board shall submit to the Assembly a proposal for excluding it as a member.
4. Candidates are requested to submit to the MMI secretariat a formal application form with key information about the organizations, its objectives and activities and its governance and funding (organization's profile).
5. According to the Statutes, the decision on the admission of new members is taken by the Board, based on the information provided. There is no entitlement for membership. Candidates have no explicit right to further explain and defend their admission request. The Board reports to the Assembly about admissions and rejected applications.
6. The organization's profile of new Network members will be published on the electronic platform of the MMI Network. All current Network members are recommended to publish their own profiles in a similar way and to regularly update them.
